Task Description:	
<p>You are required to choose a modern (year 2010 and up) TV show, movie or documentary and study the parenting style and behaviour management demonstrated in your chosen media. You need to critically examine the following aspects in a written essay:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The parenting style demonstrated in your chosen media- Behaviour management strategies used and their effectiveness- Impact of parenting style on child/children- Current trends in parenting styles and behaviour management	





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You need to structure your assessment as an essay including introduction, body and conclusion paragraphs (see scaffold provided). You must also provide a reference list and correctly reference sources.

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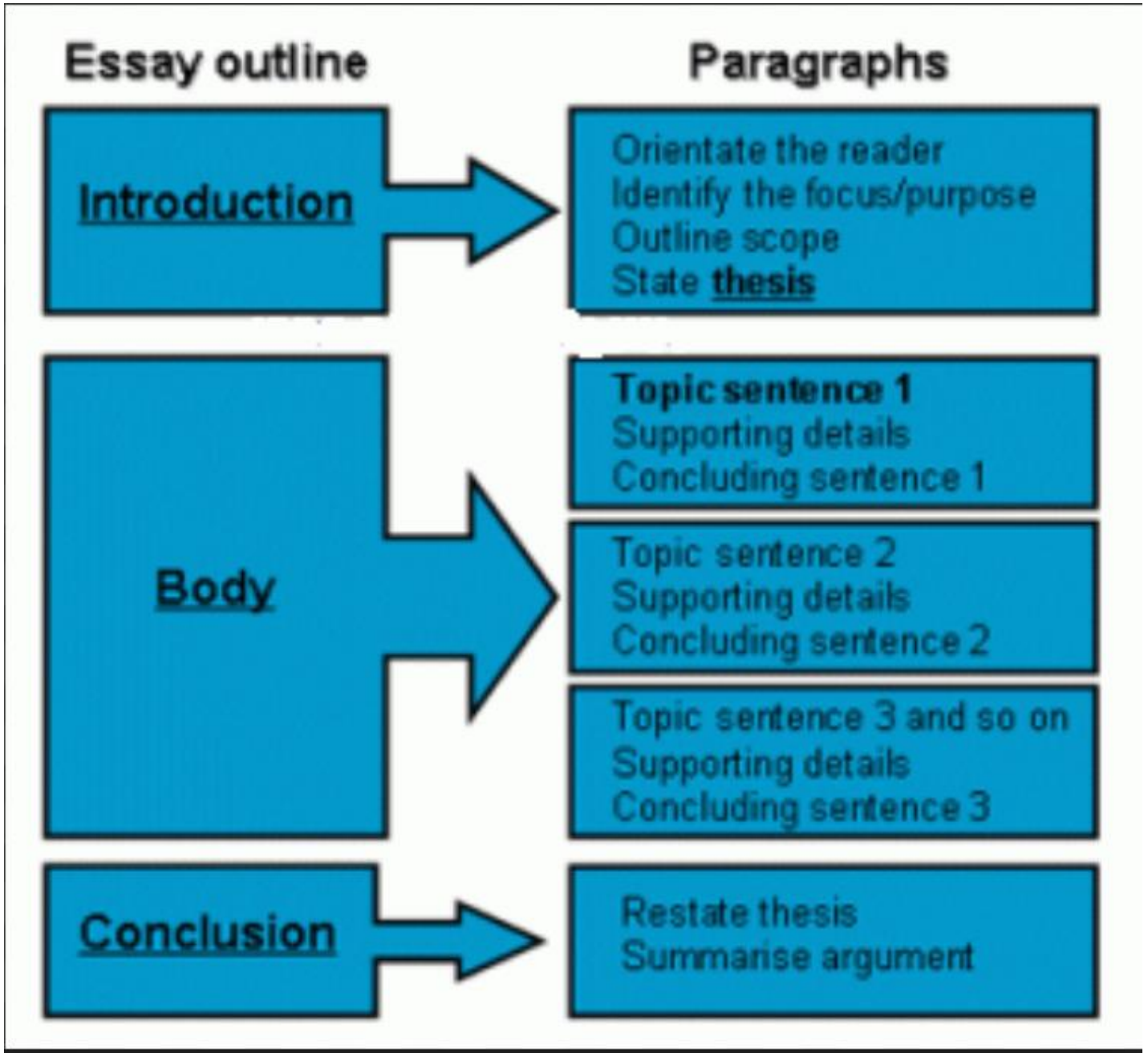
