Task Context:

In this topic you have learnt about the concept of wellbeing and resource management. It is important to effectively manage resources in order to enhance an individual's wellbeing.

In this task you will identify, compare and analyse wellbeing and resources management in relation to a variety of individuals and circumstances within the movie 'The Blind side'.

Task Description:

You are to watch the movie 'The Blind Side' and answer the following questions. This will be shown in class during week 6. If you are absent you will need to organise to watch this is your own time. It is available on ClickView (via a teacher's login) Stan, Foxtel Go and Apple TV.

You are to write a response to the following questions.

- <u>Describe</u> each of the specific needs (Safety and Security, Health, Education, Sense of identity, Employment, Adequate standard of living) (6 marks)
- 2. <u>Compare</u> the significance of the specific needs of Sean Junior (SJ) and Michael Oher, up to and including the point where Michael is adopted by the Tuohy family. (6 marks)











- Explain how the six factors affecting wellbeing (Social, Physical, Emotional, Economic, Cultural, Spiritual) impact the wellbeing of THREE characters in the movie. (8 marks)
- 4. Analyse how the relationship between the factors impacts each character. (10 marks)

Characters to use include; Michael Oher, Leigh Anne Tuohy (mum), Sean Tuohy (dad), SJ Tuohy (brother) and Collins Tuohy (daughter).

All questions need to be answered in an organised, logical and coherent manner, using correct syllabus terminology
