Task Context:

This term in English, you have studied the biography and autobiography genres. You have explored the ways these personal stories can be told in written or media forms.

Course Outcomes:

EN4-ECA-01: creates personal, creative and critical texts for a range of audiences by using linguistic and stylistic conventions of language to express ideas

Task Description:

You will create your own autobiographical multi-modal text which tells the story of your life, or a small part of your life, as if you were presenting it to your class. A multi-modal text must include at least two of the following modes of representation:

- Visual (what your audience can see, e.g. images or recordings)
- Aural (what your audience can hear, e.g. music, voices, sound effects)
- Gestural (movements, e.g. facial expressions, hand gestures, body language, interaction between characters)
- Linguistic (written or spoken words)

Your autobiography should take between 2-5 minutes to view.

Some suggested texts that meet the criteria include:

- A video recording of you speaking to the camera
- A PowerPoint or Prezi presentation
- A brochure or pamphlet, including both images and words
- A picture book that includes both images and words

Criteria for Assessing Learning:

You will be assessed on your ability to:

- Apply the conventions of the autobiography genre to their own text
- Effectively use two or more modes to communicate information
- Edit their work for meaning and clarity
