Task Context:

This semester, you have learnt about 'Changing Rights and Freedoms' and 'Popular Culture' in the modern world.

In this test, you will demonstrate your knowledge of these topics and your ability to analyse historic sources.

Syllabus Content:

Task Description:

You will sit an in class test at a time in Week 8 designated by your class teacher. This test will comprise of 3 sections.

Section I – Multiple Choice (10 marks)

- You will need to identify the correct answer from 4 different options.
- This section will test your knowledge of 'Popular Culture' in the modern world.

Section II – Short Answer (20 marks)

- You will need to complete short written responses to 10 questions.
- 3 of the questions in this section will require you to evaluate the usefulness of unseen historic sources.
- This section will test your knowledge of 'Changing Rights and Freedoms' in the modern world.

Section III – Extended Response (20 marks)

- You will need to write an extended response to an unseen question.
- Your extended response should include an introduction, 3 PEEL paragraphs and a conclusion.
- You will need to identify and evaluate the usefulness of an unseen historic source in supporting this response.
- This section will test your knowledge of 'Popular Culture' in the modern world.

- Content knowledge of the topics 'Changing Rights and Freedoms' and 'Popular Culture'.

- Ability to evaluate the usefulness of historic sources.
