Task Context:				

You have explored mashups in Term 1 and Term 2, learning how they are put together effectively. You will be required to compose and perform your own mashup to demonstrate your skills and understanding.

Task Description:

You will be required to create your own mashup using **two** existing songs. You will perform your mashup using either a backing track or a live accompaniment.

Criteria for Assessing Learning:

To be successful in this task you must:

- Select two songs that fit together effectively (lyrical theme, chord progression, key signature, time signature) and ensure the piece is at least 2 minutes in length.
- Perform with confidence as a soloist or in an ensemble.
- Ensure the song choices are appropriate (if unsure please see your teacher).
- Ensure you know your lyrics, chords, and melody.
- Submit the lyrics/chord sheet of your mashup that is clearly titled with your name and the mashup song title.
- Ensure your performance is organised, with your instruments being tuned/voiced warmed up beforehand.
